Since establishing our catering kitchens in 2003 we provide our nurseries and schools exclusively with food of organic origin (Kontrollstelle DE-ÖKO-006).

Even organic might differ;  
therefore we as well support

1. Die Bruderhahn Initiative Deutschland (B.I.D.),  
which takes action against economically reasoned  
shredding or gas to death of male chicklets.

Means, we obtain eggs for breakfast at the kita  
only from companies which joined the B.I.D.



2. A mother attached calf rearing.  
As of recently, some farms in northern Germany  
offer milk gained from so called mother attached  
calf rearing.

These calves are not parted from their mother  
a day after being born and fed with milk substitute.  
Instead they stay with the mother cow,  
until they feed themselves independently.  
Being fed on their mother's milk, leads to  
better mental and physical health of the calves.

This means: From March 20th 2017 on we  
are using milk of this special animal farming only,  
depending on availability.

Along with these initiatives for a better  
animal welfare we embrace the hazard of  
accepting higher prices for this food.
